### When should my student arrive at school every day?

Doors will open for students at 8:15 AM. No students will be admitted until that time. All students walking or being dropped off must enter in through the gym doors in the back of the building. Only buses will be allowed into the front parking lot. Those students will be released off of the buses at 8:15 to enter into the front doors of the building. Students will then enter and go directly to their teacher's classroom. All students should be in class, seated, and ready to learn by 8:30 AM.

# Are students required to wear masks at school?

Yes, everyone in the building must wear a mask at all times.

# Will students be health screened before entering the building?

Students riding buses will be temperature screened before they board the bus. Students who are being dropped off or walking to school will be temperature screened before they enter the building in the back.

# How long is the school day for my student?

The LES school day is 8:30-1:45.

### Will my student have locker access?

No, in order to reduce the risk of exposure, students will not be issued lockers.

### Will my student participate in PE?

There will be PE classes daily.

#### Will my student eat lunch at school?

Yes. Students will have assigned lunch and recess times daily. Students will not be eating breakfast on campus, however, we will still be offering a bagged breakfast for students who request them.

#### What will my student be doing on days that they are not at school?

Students will be remote learners on all school days that they are not in attendance at school. Students should still be logging into their student accounts and checking in with their teachers for daily lessons and assignments.

# Should students bring their devices to school daily?

Yes. Students will be required to bring their school-issued devices to school daily. The devices should be fully charged in order to accommodate a full day's worth of instruction. Students should not bring their own devices to school.
