This letter is to inform you that **Emily G. Johns School** will be moving to Remote Learning for **ALL** students for the weeks of November 9th and November 16th.

Our school health officials and administrators have worked closely with the Kendall County Health Department on a recent, confirmed case at Emily G. Johns School. Although there is only one confirmed case at this time, we have decided to move to Remote Learning to mitigate risk and exposure to our students.

The decision to move to remote learning was not made without careful considerations. Due to the evolving situation we will be working with the health department to monitor the situation and plan to return to in-person learning the week of November 30th.

If it is determined that your child is a “close contact” and is required to quarantine at home, you will be notified by the school district.

As we shift to remote learning, we recognize the importance of maintaining a consistent schedule for our students. Therefore, all in-person students will continue with their current schedule as follows:

- Every Monday will continue to be a Virtual Learning day and students will follow the current Monday Schedule provided by their teacher.
- Students on “Track A” will follow their schedule remotely by participating in Zoom meetings with their teachers on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Students on “Track A” will continue to complete assignments provided by their teacher on Wednesdays and Fridays.
- Students on “Track B” will follow their schedule remotely by participating in Zoom meetings with their teachers on Wednesday and Fridays. Students on “Track B” will continue to complete assignments provided by their teacher on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
