In addition to university-awarded scholarships, each year the College of Engineering grants over \$3 million in scholarships to engineering students. The generous support of hundreds of individuals and corporations allows us to recognize the academic accomplishments of outstanding, hard-working students.

First-year Students

Scholarship eligibility for incoming first-year students is based on a high school GPA of 3.6 or higher.

The engineering scholarship application will include two essay questions.

Scholarship Application Deadline

December 15, 2020

Award details

lowa residents: \$2,600/year

Domestic non-lowa residents: \$5,250/year

Guaranteed* for 2 years (4 semesters) if selected

Acceptance and Renewal

Students must accept the offer of admission by May 1, 2021 in order to receive any scholarship they may be offered.

*Students are required to achieve a 2.7 cumulative GPA in Fall 2021, remain enrolled in the College of Engineering, and complete an online scholarship application in November 2021 to continue the award their second year.

Transfer Students

Scholarships through the College of Engineering are awarded to transfer students on the basis of academic ability as measured by ACT or SAT scores (if taken), grades earned in basic program courses at transfer school(s), and essay responses.

Students must apply to be considered for transfer scholarships.

Scholarship Application Deadlines:

- June 1, 2021 for Fall 2021 Entry
- January 1, 2022 for Spring 2022 Entry

Current Students

Scholarships for current engineering students are selected and awarded each spring semester for the following academic year and are based primarily on academic performance and/or financial need; however, activities, leadership, work experience, etc. may also be used as criteria for selection.

Each November students must apply for scholarships via an online scholarship application. The deadline is typically February 1.

This single application allows students an opportunity to renew any awards they have received from the college, as well as compete for hundreds of scholarships not available to them as incoming freshmen.
