Possible Exposure of COVID-19 on the Cross Country Team

November 9, 2020

Dear Parents,

I received notification that an athlete on our cross country team was exposed to a COVID positive person. This athlete is exhibiting no symptoms, therefore, per the health department guidance, your child is only listed as a *possible* exposure, which does not require contact tracing or quarantine for your child. Your child has a *possible* exposure to someone who was exposed to a COVID positive person. This athlete is not COVID positive, but has been exposed to a COVID positive person.

While I must protect the privacy of the person involved, I believe it is best to communicate transparently with you so you can make well-informed decisions for your family. There is nothing more important to Bloomington Schools than the safety and health of our students, our staff and their families.

It is important for our students and families to remain vigilant in practicing all the appropriate safety protocols. The CDC recommends the following best practices to help prevent the spread:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid close contact with those who are sick.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue or your sleeve.
- Avoid touching your eyes, mouth and nose.
- Disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects.
- If you must go out, practice social distancing, leaving at least six feet between you and other people.
- Avoid gatherings that include more than 10 people.


