Southeast Colorado Power Association (SECPA) will be offering **five** \$1,000 scholarships to **students whose parents are members of SECPA**.

At the same time, Tri-State Generation and Transmission also offers a \$1,000 scholarship to eligible students.

Qualifying requirements for these scholarships are as follows:

- 1. Student's parents must be a member of SECPA.
- 2. The student must be a graduating senior for the 2020-2021 school year.
- 3. Student must plan to attend a two or four year college, or trade or other non-traditional secondary educational institutions. Along with the student's application, we need copies of their school transcript, letters of recommendation and a short letter stating why they feel they are deserving and what their major will be in school. We will also need a current photograph (DIGITAL HIGH-RESOLUTION, FULL SIZE PREFERRED.) Email to debbieh@sepca.com.

In addition, Basin Electric will be awarding a \$1000 scholarship to one student in the SECPA member territory. With this application, students must have maintained at least a **3.8 grade point average**, and meet the same criteria as in paragraph three above. Students may apply for both the SECPA/Tri-State Scholarship, as well as the Basin.

All eligible students may apply for any or all three of the above-described scholarships.

When applying for the Southeast Colorado Power or Tri-State scholarships, use the SECPA/ Tri-State Scholarship Application. If applying for the Basin Scholarship, use the Basin Application.
