Distance Learning Definitions:

(student/teacher in separate locations)

Asynchronous: Learning in which the student and teacher are not connected in real time (not live). Requires students to independently complete tasks and activities. Methods of learning include: self-guided lesson modules, streaming video content, virtual libraries, posted lecture notes, & exchange across discussion boards or social media platforms.

Synchronous: Learning in which the student and teacher are electronically connected in real time/live, interacting in a specific virtual place, through a specific online medium, at a specific time.
