## Morton ISD Basketball Gym Seating Plan

Available Seating Capacity at Morton High  
School gymnasium under 2020-2021 / UIL 50%

- All fans/spectators will enter and exit the main entrance and must submit to screening requirements in place according to guidelines and wear masks at all times except when eating or drinking.
- Student athletes will need to sit in the area designated as **Team Seating**, unless he/she has a game voucher.
- Concessions will be available at most games and allowed to be taken into gym seating sections (seating in foyer will be limited by 50% for gathering and eating)
- Ticket prices for all games will be \$3 for adults and \$2 for students.
- **Home Team Fans:** 140 Season Voucher tickets will go on sale for PARENTS OF ATHLETES (ball players and cheer team) Wednesday, November 11th, through Monday, November 16th, 8:30a.m until 4p.m. Parents may purchase up to 4 vouchers Adult Season Vouchers are \$40 and Student Vouchers are \$28 (16 games).
- **Any remaining Season Voucher tickets** will be placed in lottery drawings prior to each game. Community members will need to sign up for the lottery drawing. Lottery drawing winners will be able to **purchase two Vouchers**. A new lottery drawing will occur prior to each home game (drawn Monday afternoon for Tuesday games and Thursday afternoon for Friday games).
- **Everyone who signs up will be eligible for EVERY LOTTERY DRAWING for each season home game that we have tickets for (they will not need to sign up again).** Winners of each drawing will be put back in the pot for the next game's drawing. Indian Fans need to call (806-266-5505) or stop by the Administration Office to sign up for the drawing any time from 8:30a.m to 4p.m. beginning Nov. 11th through Thursday November 19th at NOON.
- **Morton Fans Visiting other Districts for games:** A separate ticket/voucher must be obtained for each game date spectators wish to attend and will be valid for all games on that date. MISD will either receive vouchers (which will be available on a first come first served basis at the Admin Office- 4 ticket per family limit), or fans will be directed towards a different ticket purchase method (such as on-line ticket sales or first come first served at the opposing team's gym).
