



Winter Weather Procedures for the Trenton R-IX School District

Trenton, MO, November 10, 2020: To help the R-IX community be better prepared for the approaching winter weather, the Trenton R-IX School District is sharing the following procedures which will be in place for the 2020-2021 school year.

2. In the event of a late start, all schedules for students grades K-12 will be on a 2 hour delay. School will begin at 10:00 am, and bus routes will be delayed by 2 hours. On days with a late start, there will be no breakfast served throughout the district.
 3. In the event that school is in session, and weather conditions force the school district to release students early, all after school activities and programs will be cancelled.
 4. The preschool schedule will vary. On late start days, there will be no morning sessions of preschool, but afternoon sessions will meet. On early out days, there will be no afternoon sessions of preschool.
 5. District personnel will use information from local, state, and national weather organizations to make determinations about dismissing or cancelling school. In addition, road conditions, wind chill temperatures, and student safety will be evaluated to determine what is best for students and staff of the Trenton R-IX District.
