The Geneva Area City School District wishes to inform you that the Local Health Department is investigating cases of COVID-19 at Geneva High School and Geneva Middle School. During the time that the cases were potentially infectious, the students were in the school buildings the following days:

Student 1: Geneva MS (7th grade) - Last day in school Thursday, November 5, 2020 Student 2: Geneva HS (10th Grade) - Last day in school Tuesday, November 3, 2020 Student 3: Geneva HS (10th Grade) - Last day in school Monday, November 9, 2020

The cases reported to have visited only Geneva Middle School (student 1) and Geneva High School (students 2 / 3) on the last days indicated above. The students received positive test results as of today and the district was notified.

COVID-19 is a contagious respiratory disease that is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person from people who are in close contact. Generally, close contact is defined as being within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more. Symptoms of COVID-19 typically appear 2-14 days after exposure and may include fever/chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficult breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.
