- WHEREAS,** The New Jersey School Boards Association and the National School Boards Association have declared January 2011 to be School Board Recognition Month, a time that all residents might acknowledge the contributions made by our local school board members; and
- WHEREAS,** The East Hanover Township Board of Education is one of more than 600 local school boards in New Jersey that sets policies and oversees operations for public school districts; and
- WHEREAS,** The East Hanover Township Board of Education embraces the goal of high-quality education for all New Jersey public school students; and
- WHEREAS,** New Jersey’s local school boards help determine community goals for the education of 1.4 million children in Pre-Kindergarten through 12th grade; and
- WHEREAS,** New Jersey’s 4,800 local school board members, who receive no remuneration for their services, act as advocates for public school students as they work with administrators, teachers and parents for the betterment of public education; and
- WHEREAS,** School boards strive to provide the resources necessary to meet the needs of all students, including those with special needs; and

WHEREAS, Boards of education provide accountability to the public; they communicate the needs of the school district to the public; and they convey to school administrators the public’s expectations for the schools; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey can take pride in its schools, which rank among the nation’s best in indicators such as high school graduation rates, class size, college entrance exam participation, and Advanced Placement offerings and test scores. Now, therefore, be it
