We have learned that a Bath Tech student has tested positive for COVID-19. Similar to the situation in RSU 1 earlier this week, our staff and students are not considered "close contacts". There is no need for school closure because of the time that passed between the individual being at the school and testing positive. We are notifying staff and families out of an abundance of caution.

Upon learning of the confirmed positive test, we implemented our response protocol. We must follow privacy laws and protect the confidentiality interests of every student and staff member, while also ensuring that we are protecting the health and well-being of all members of our school community. We are committed to keeping our students and staff safe and appreciate our working relationship with the Maine Department of Education, Maine CDC, and school physician, Dr. Amina Hanna.
