



Per Health Department recommendations - CCS will set a maximum capacity limit of 100 spectators at all athletic events in order to practice recommended social distancing guidelines.

1. Visiting Teams will be allowed 1 ticket per athlete/cheerleader (up to 25 per team). CCS Athletes will be allowed 2 tickets per athlete/cheerleader***. High School students enrolled at CCS will be allowed one ticket. We recommend that the tickets be used by someone who lives in the same household of the participant to stay within the guidelines and to make sure that there is someone from the household on site if a participant requires medical attention.
 1. When multiple teams are on site for a tournament, teams who are not playing will be asked to leave the building to allow for other teams' spectators to enter the building.
 2. Visiting Teams will be required to submit a roster to the CCS Athletic Director with the number of tickets they will need for each contest no later than the Sunday night of the week of the scheduled contest.
 3. CCS coaches will be required to submit a roster to the CCS Athletic Director with the number of tickets they will need for each contest no later than the Sunday night of the week of the scheduled contest.
 4. CCS high school students will be required to submit their name to the main office if they wish to purchase a ticket no later than the Sunday night of the week of the scheduled contest.
 5. All sales will be completed at CCS upon entry of the scheduled contest and when the maximum number of allotted tickets have been purchased, the ticket sales window will close.
2. All spectators need to wear a mask when moving about the building and when social distancing is not possible. Please practice social distancing where possible.
3. Please remain seated as much as possible during the scheduled contest and do not congregate in the hallways and entrances where social distancing is difficult. All children should be supervised by their parents/guardians at all times.
4. Proper cleaning/sanitizing protocols will be completed.
5. All concessions will be pre-packaged items.
6. Entry/Exit locations will be marked as One Way (enter through the Main School Entrance/exit through the Middle Entrance between the church and the school).
7. All CCS families will be notified if there are any unclaimed tickets prior to a scheduled contest.

****Mini-cheer participants/spectators will not be charged to attend when the mini-cheer team is performing, but they will be limited to 4 spectators per mini-cheerleader. Mini-cheer performances will be at the beginning of the contest and we are asking that all mini-cheer participants/spectators exit the building immediately following their performance.*
