Recruits undergo a twenty-six (26) hour orientation program where they learn such subjects as military history, customs and courtesies, close order drill, physical fitness, and military structure. After graduating from Young Marines Recruit Training they can proudly call themselves Young Marine, wear the Young Marine uniform and work towards awards. The Young Marines offers encampments and national programs.

The Young Marines promotes mental, moral and physical development. The program focuses on character building, discipline, and leadership, and promotes life long dedication to being a productive member of society.

Honoring veterans is not just something we talk about it's what we do! A majority of officers are military veterans. We visit military installations, board Navy and Coast Guard ships, visit veterans homes, are part of "Wreaths Across America", and march in parades.
