Dear Bixby Spartan Parent or Guardian,

In accordance with the *Every Student Succeeds Act/*PARENTS' RIGHT-TO-KNOW, this is a notification from Bixby Public School District to every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right to request and receive information in a timely manner regarding

- 1. The professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers. The information regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers shall include the following:
 - If the teacher has met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas taught
 - If the teacher is teaching under emergency or temporary status in which the state qualifications and licensing criteria are waived
 - The teacher's baccalaureate degree major, graduate certification, and field of discipline
 - Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications
- 2. Information regarding any State or local educational agency policy regarding student participation in any assessments mandated by section 1111(b)(2) and by the State or local educational agency, which shall include a policy, procedure, or parental right to opt the child out of such assessment, where applicable. [ESSA 1112(e)(2)(A)]
- 3. Upon request, parents of an English learner may
 - a. Have the child immediately removed from an English Learner (EL) program [ESSA 1112(e)(3)(A)(viii)(i)]
 - b. Decline the child's enrollment in an EL program, or choose another program or method of instruction, if available; [ESSA, Section 1112(e)(3)(A)(viii)(ii)]
 - c. Receive assistance in selecting among various programs and methods of instruction, if more than one program or method is offered by the eligible entity. [ESSA1112(e)(3)(A)(viii)(iii)]

In addition to the above information you will be notified if your student has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet the applicable state certification for licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned. [ESSA 1112(e)(1)(B)(ii)].
