Today, Nov 12th the Champaign County Health Department pushed out an email to all Champaign County Schools and held a press conference this afternoon recommending all Champaign County Schools consider going to remote learning until January 5th due to the increase spreading of the virus in the county.

Unit 7 Schools will remain in session with in-person learning until Friday, November 20, 2020; the district will then utilize Remote Learning Planning days on November 23rd and 24th during the week of Thanksgiving.

There will be no in-person or remote classes for students on November 23rd and 24th.

Remote learning will begin on Monday, November 30th and we will continue in remote learning until January 4th.

Please understand that what I am sharing with you today is subject to change any minute from guidelines produced by the county health department/IDPH, State Board of Education and the Governor's office.
