Parent-Teacher Conferences

Conferences will be hosted this year via Zoom on Monday, November 23, from 1:15-4 pm and Wednesday, November 24, from 5-8 pm. Middle school conferences run a bit differently than in elementary schools, as MJS parent-teacher conferences are designed for families with students that might be struggling. Teaching teams have already invited via email those families where a conference is recommended.

All families are welcome to email their child's team leader *at any time* to schedule a check-in phone call or video conference to ask, "how is my child doing...how can I support him/her/them at home." Sign Up Genius links for conferences will be emailed to the community on Wednesday afternoon, November 18.

Please note, the week of Thanksgiving, there will be no Periods 789 on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday due to conferences and the holiday.

MJS Advisory Program

We are pleased to announce that we will commence our advisory program with the start of marking period two. Advisory will take place virtually every Wednesday during 7th period (1:30-2 pm) starting December 2. Attendance at advisory is mandatory.

The advisory period will be held once a week with small groups of students and a staff member mentor. Discussion topics and activities will include essential elements of character education, such as teamwork and problem-solving. Once per month, 8th grade Peer Leaders will lead outreach sessions to their 6th-grade peers, while all other 8th graders participate in community service projects.

Students will receive an email from Google Classroom on Monday, December 1, to join their advisory group classroom. Advisor mentors can be found on the student schedule listed as Period 7W. We are very excited to get this valuable MJS program running for our students!

An app where students can read library books on any device (ebooks, audiobooks, read-alongs, etc.)

How to log in:

- Go to ClassLink (under madisonnjps.org bookmarks).
 Sign in with Google.
- 3. Click on the Overdrive (Sora) icon (pictured above).

How to browse and checkout books:

- Browse by: available now, popular subjects, new additions, most popular, or the entire collection (your next great read).
- Click on a book. Read a sample, borrow the book, or put it on hold (if it is currently being read by another student).
- Books remain on the student's device for 2 weeks, but can be returned early.
