Parents and Eden Community,

Eden CISD has been notified that 2 students have tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy requirements, we will not release the name of the individuals or details that may identify them.

Working with the Department of Health and Human Services, Eden CISD has already contacted anyone who came in close contact with the individual. Prior to continued use, the District has completed disinfection of all areas heavily used by the individual with the lab-confirmed case.

Out of an abundance of caution, we advise everyone to monitor their health, follow the [CDC guidelines for people who have had close contact](#) and contact your primary care physician if you develop symptoms. Any of the following symptoms indicate a possible COVID-19 infection:

- Temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth;
- Sore throat;
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (or, for students with a chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline);
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain; or
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.

Eden CISD is continuing to monitor this situation and will provide additional information as needed. We hope for a successful recovery for our staff members.
