2020-21 Willowbrook Transition Information for 8th Grade Students

In the past, Willowbrook High School has worked with us to use various sources of information to place students in Freshman courses at WBHS. These items included the PSAT, 8th grade fall MAP data, teacher recommendation, GPA, and student/parent/guardian input. Given the current condition and limitations, the PSATs are not being administered. Due to this change, Willowbrook Department Chairs and Administration met with our 8th Grade Teachers and Administration to identify alternatives for these assessments in both ELA and Math. Our teams are working together to identify resources that could be used for placement considerations at WBHS. The WBHS Administration will communicate in greater detail at a later time once everything is finalized, but this is a general overview of our work thus far.

What can your 8th grader do? The answer is simple. Just remind your child to do his/her best on all classroom assignments, as good work habits increase assessment scores and provide a great foundation for both 8th grade and high school success.

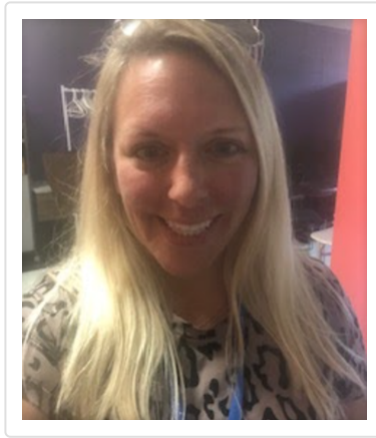

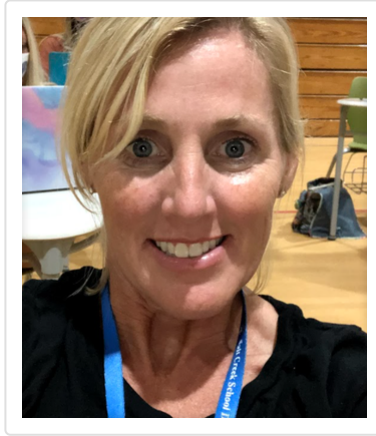
Favorite Color? I really like black if no one can tell.
