Weather-Related School Closing and Early Dismissal Information

The Board has authorized the Superintendent to close the schools in the event of hazardous weather or other emergencies which endanger the safety of students, staff, or school property. If school is cancelled, parents will be notified via Skylert, the District website (www.mahometseymour.org), Twitter and local TV and radio stations. Decisions are made as early as possible and are generally announced prior to 6 a.m.

If it becomes necessary to dismiss students early due to weather conditions, every effort will be made to provide at least one-hour notice to parents. *During times of inclement weather, please do not contact the Transportation Department or your child's school unless it is an emergency.*

Early Dismissal Schedule

Buildings are dismissed on a staggered schedule:
Middletown & Sangamon – announced dismissal time
Lincoln Trail – 10 minutes later than announced time
High School – 20 minutes later than announced time
Jr. High – 30 minutes later than announced time

Special Instructions for Parents with Students in Kids Club/BLAST

The decision to dismiss school early or cancel after-school activities is generally made by 1 p.m. On these days, and the Kids Club/BLAST After-School Program will also be cancelled.

If the decision to cancel after-school activities is made after 1 p.m.: Only the Kids Club After-School Program will be open and parents are encouraged to pick up their students as early as possible.
