Tuxedo offers a **full-day** Pre-Kindergarten program starting at 8:30am and ending at 2:30pm.

In the Classroom

The Pre-K staff consists of a highly qualified Early Childhood Education teacher, Mrs. Amanda Sayles, and two classroom aides with support personnel such as a school nurse, speech therapist, and occupational therapist.

From every detail of the design of our new Pre-K classroom featuring all new furniture, toys, and supplies, to our high standards of cleanliness, we do everything to ensure our children are safe and secure. The Tuxedo UFSD has partnered and is continuously planning with the Creative Curriculum program to support the educational needs of our students.

Our Pre-K classroom is located in the George Grant Mason Elementary School in Tuxedo. The Pre-K students follow the Tuxedo School District calendar and attend school 180 days.

Registration Details

Children *must be 4 years old* on or before December 1 of that school year in order to be eligible for the program. The Pre-K is free to residents of the Tuxedo school district. Out-of-district tuition is \$9000 per year (September 2020-June 2021).
