## Holds

All students have accounts set up in Destiny and are able to place holds on books. Once a hold is placed, the book will be pulled, checked out and made available in the office. An email will be sent to the parent's email we have on file once the books are ready to be picked up.

# Follow these steps:

- Go to our school <u>homepage</u> and choose Menu--Technology Links--Nippersink D2 Library or use this <u>link</u>. Students might also have a link titled D2 Destiny Library in their bookmarks on their Chromebooks.
- 2. Choose Spring Grove school from the school options.
- 3. Click login in the upper right hand corner.
- 4. The login is the beginning of their Google account (everything before the @) and the same password as their Google account. If

- 5. Once in Destiny you can search using the search bar or you can browse the new book ribbon or the topic section of the homepage.
- 6. When you find a book you want, click the Hold button. Only holds placed on books that are "IN" will be available right away.

## **EBooks**

## **Book Return**

Books can be returned to our outside drop box located outside the main office anytime or brought into the office when picking up new holds during school hours. Any books that are returned will be quarantined for 7 days before they are put back into circulation.
