

Thanksgiving Week: Numbers remain relatively moderate for student and staff absences today. District-wide we have forty-eight (48) students and eleven (11) staff members out due to COVID related concerns with the vast majority not directly infected. So for the abbreviated week of Monday - Tuesday prior to Thanksgiving we will be continuing with school as this past week. Face to face at the Elementary Schools and the Middle School while the High School will be Cohort A on Monday; Cohort B on Tuesday.

In order to allow you to prepare ahead the following decisions have been made.

After Thanksgiving: The Campbellsport School District will be virtual the week after Thanksgiving (Nov. 30 - Dec. 4). Instruction will continue for all students in all grades. Your student's Principal will be notifying you of the specific expectations for that week. This is being done due to the exposure risks that will be occurring during this time of increased family mixing. The week will allow any transmission of the virus to present symptoms prior to school resuming on December 7th. This will allow us to complete the two weeks and two days before the Christmas break per the school calendar.

After the New Year: Following this same model, we will be going virtual for one week (Jan. 4 - 8) after the Christmas break. Depending on total positive cases in the District and County during that week will determine how we continue beyond that. We will be sending future communications on these adjustments.
