Attention all Tecumseh High School Students and Parent/Guardians

Procedures to expect during distance learning:

1. Teachers can be contacted through CANVAS or school email. Students are expected to check these two avenues for communication DAILY.
2. Teachers will be providing classwork through CANVAS or Edgenuity. Teachers have been training students on how to use Canvas since August. All students know how to use CANVAS and submit assignments. If you have questions about passwords, please email a counselor or a principal.
3. Teachers will have office hours each day for you or your student to email and expect a reply for assistance. Teachers are still working a normal work day, so you can expect those office hours (which will vary and likely correspond to their planning period).
4. Many teachers will be scheduling Zooms or Google meets and students are expected to attend. On the days these are scheduled, they will correspond with normal class time.
5. Any assignments given during times of distance learning "COUNT" and are factored into student grades. Grades will be taken, due dates will be respected and students are expected to be responsible. Do not wait until after a due date to contact a teacher if there is a problem.
6. Current school announcements will be updated every day on Mrs. Griggs' Canvas page under the "Announcements" tab. You can also still check out virtual books under Mrs. Peak's page and contact your counselor if needed on their Canvas pages.
