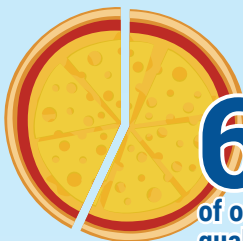

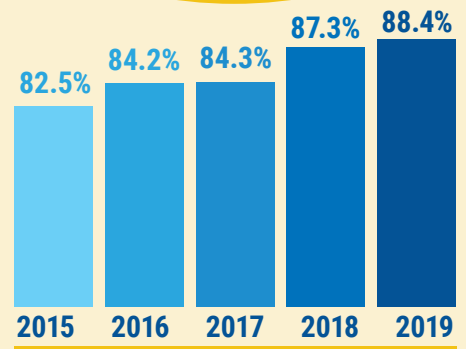

# FALL 2020 OPTIONS

Based on current county health conditions and state requirements.  
Students commit to their path through the current grading period.

## OPTION 1: YOUR SCHOOL

### START → Continuous Learning 2.0

Full remote learning for ALL students, per Department of Health (DoH) recommendations

- A new, robust learning delivery model will be used
- Students will receive **DAILY** instruction from teachers
- A Chromebook will be provided for every student



### THEN ←

Pivot to Hybrid when DoH metrics allow, Task Force reviews, and Kelso school board approves.

## OPTION 2: KELSO VIRTUAL ACADEMY



### Flexible Online Learning

Students enroll in KVA and commit to at least 1 trimester (elementary & HS) or 1 semester (MS).

- Full virtual K-12 Alternative Learning Experience (ALE) school
- Students will do all school work online in a **flexible schedule model**
- Specifically designed online curriculum
- K-12 students receive **weekly required communication** with advising teacher
- District provides Chromebook technology to students



## Hybrid Remote/In-Person

Combination of in-person and remote instruction each week, with these safety/health precautions in place:

- Sanitizing
- Physical distancing
- Masks/shields
- Health monitoring
