Other important reminders for students and parents:

- If you have a COVID-19 test, you must stay home until you receive results.
- If someone in your household tests positive, you must quarantine.
- If a student is quarantined, the student should not leave home.

If a child does not feel well, the child should not come to school. Nurse Knueven and I are happy to take your call and help decide if your child should be at school or not. It is better to call and discuss your concerns before sending your child to school, and possibly affecting others, this call will allow us to help discern what could possibly be something that needs a little down time at home to play out or may warrant a visit to the physician.

Another reminder is that the cold and flu season is here now too. We want to be diligent with our efforts to remain in-person at school. Remember the safe practices of what we know works best for combating germs and spreading disease:

- continue to wash hands often
- use hand sanitizer when you can't wash your hands
- avoid touching your face
- wear a mask/shield
- Social distancing when possible and avoiding large gatherings
