Good Afternoon,

We are writing to inform you that although two of our Pre-K classrooms have gone remote, they were **not** a result of Covid-19 exposure or positive tests within the classrooms. The two Pre-K classrooms are going remote, as we are no longer able to fully support them due to the number of staff in quarantine resulting from Covid-19 exposure while outside of school. As the faculty members were exposed to Covid-19 but have not tested positive or been symptomatic, there was no requirement for notifications of close contacts. The classrooms will return to the remote model effective Thursday, November 19, 2020, and resume our current model on Wednesday, December 2, 2020.

Our first responsibility is to keep our students and staff safe. We continue to remind our student body and staff to adhere to the safety protocols including, mask-wearing, hand washing, and social distancing. These measures, taken in combination, significantly reduce the risk of additional transmission. As a reminder, our general notification guidance is as follows:

- We will notify close contacts of anyone who is symptomatic or tests positive.
- If someone is asymptomatic but tests positive, close contacts will be notified as a result of the positive test.
- If someone is asymptomatic OR tests negative, no notifications are required.

We will continue to be vigilant in adhering to all of the protocols that have been put in place. We are also providing remote learning for all students affected by this situation to continue to provide instruction, structure, and an emotional connection to the classroom during a time that we know will be challenging for those children and families involved.
