VAN VLECK HIGH SCHOOL NEW GYM TICKETING

Game Order: JV (GIRLS or BOYS), Varsity GIRLS, **CLEAR GYM IF NECESSARY**, Varsity BOYS

Home Side Occupancy: 235; Do NOT sit on taped rows.

Visitor Side Occupancy: 235; Do NOT sit on taped rows.

- All tickets will be first-come, first-serve online.

VAN VLECK ISD PRACTICE GYM TICKETING

Home & Visitor Occupancy: 252; Do NOT sit on taped rows.

MIDDLE SCHOOL TICKETING PLAN: All home junior high basketball games will be played at the OHHMS GYM and VAN VLECK ISD PRACTICE GYM.

OHHMS GYM – Home & Visitor Occupancy: 144; Do NOT sit on taped rows.

Home & Visitor Occupancy: 252; Do NOT sit on taped rows.

- All tickets will be first-come, first-serve and at the door.

Passes: No student, staff, THSCA/TGCA, or senior citizen passes will be accepted. Non-District DEC passes are not accepted. District DEC passes will be accepted and will count towards occupancy.

Ticketing & Capacity Protocol: Due to limited occupancy and our focus to provide ample opportunity for parents and family members to watch their athlete's game, we will utilize the following ticketing and management protocol for gym capacity.

1. Tickets will be Online and General Admission only
2. Administrators and gate workers will monitor capacity for each gymnasium
3. If the seating limit is reached, gate workers and security will close occupancy until more capacity can be made available.
4. If capacity is reached, an announcement will be made for those who have already watched their athlete play to consider exiting to increase capacity for parents needed to enter.
5. Gymnasium will be cleared only if deemed necessary and parents and family members of upcoming games will be allowed to remain.
6. This plan is based on current COVID Restrictions and could change with little notice
7. NO FOOD OR DRINK IS ALLOWED IN ANY VVISED GYMS.

Face Coverings- Executive Order GA-29
