Subject	Guidelines
Hygiene Measures	 Handwashing with be encouraged. Hand sanitizer is available in all classrooms. Cover coughs and sneezing. Stay home if feeling ill.
Cleaning of Facilities	 Cleaning procedures are in place at all buildings. All classrooms and buses will have cleaning supplies available. Cleaning solutions rated for use against COVID will be used.
Contact Tracing and Quarantines	 There will be no contact tracing and thus, no required quarantines. If a family has COVID in the household, a quarantine of family members in the household may be recommended. Students who are positive for Covid should stay home for 5 days and may return to school if experiencing no symptoms on Day 6. Upon returning to school, students are encouraged to wear a mask until Day 10.
Screening and Testing	 Our school nurses can test students exhibiting symptoms of COVID upon parent permission. Parents may also use over-the-counter COVID tests as a way to diagnose their children.
Masking	 Masking is not required. Students may wear masks if desired or if coming back to school from having COVID.
Vaccinations	 Vaccines are available through the Bourbon County Health Department, Community Health Centers of SEK, Walmart and Walgreens.
Accommodations for Children with Disabilities	 Students with an IEP, 504 Plan, and other documented support plans will have all appropriate accommodations and supports made available to them. The Board of Education and administration at USD #
Coordination with Local and State Officials	234 will consider the recommendations and guidance from our local and state health departments and other agencies when updating this plan.
