



INTERNET CONNECTIONS FOR STUDENTS

During the COVID pandemic, there are times when schools are closed to in-person learning and students must be engaged in Remote Learning. Technology and the internet play an important part in the remote learning process. Jackson County Schools has received a grant to help students that do not have internet access in their homes. The school system may be able to assign a “hot spot” to a student that does not have internet service if they live in an area that has cell phone coverage. If your child does not have access to internet service, you may call Jackson County Schools at (304) 372-7300 and ask to speak with the Technology Help Desk to discuss whether a “hot spot” would be an option for your child.

In the event that you do not have internet capability at your home, student work may be downloaded or uploaded from one of the Kids Connect Access Points at any school in Jackson County. Just look for this sign at the school to locate the access point:



If you do not have internet service, or cannot make it to the Kids Connect site at a local school, schools are providing instructional packets for students that do not have internet access. Please contact your child’s school to get information about how and when to pick up your child’s instructional packet.
