Good Afternoon,

Today, we received two new reports of students testing positive for COVID. The details of each situation are as follows:

• We received notice early this morning of a student that had tested positive in the MS/HS building. Since that child had attended school in-person this week, we needed to quarantine several teachers and students. As a result of these protocols, we could not open the building today for live instruction.

Since we now have two confirmed cases in the MS/HS that are not related, all Grade 6-12 students will be in a remote setting, returning Thursday, December 3rd.

• We also received notice that a child in Edward H. Bryan School tested positive for COVID-19. After conducting contact tracing, we determined the building could remain open for live instruction. Both Edward H. Bryan School and Merritt Memorial School will be open for live instruction on Monday, November 23rd.

In order to facilitate future reporting of COVID cases, we have created separate building-level protocols to report positive cases to our school district. Please contact the school directly by completing the separate link and leaving a voice message at the respective phone number if you, or someone in your household, tests positive for COVID:

We ask that you use the contact information listed above even if your child is in an all-virtual setting. The school district is required to report all positive COVID cases to the New Jersey Department of Education, regardless of whether the student attends live or all-virtual instruction.

Lastly, as a reminder in regards to the upcoming Thanksgiving holiday, if your family travels to a state or country identified on the quarantine list, your child will need to remain in quarantine and not attend in-person school and afterschool activities for fourteen (14) days. Testing negative for COVID-19, no matter what form of testing used, does not exempt individuals from that quarantine period. We ask that families check the most up-to-date list before traveling:
