



What Sora is

An app where students can read library books on any device (ebooks, audiobooks, read-alongs, etc.)

How to log in:

- Go to ClassLink (under madisonnjps.org bookmarks).
 Sign in with Google.
- 3. Click on the Overdrive (Sora) icon (pictured above).

How to browse and checkout books:

- · Browse by: available now, popular subjects, new additions, most popular, or the entire collection (your next great read).
- Click on a book. Read a sample, borrow the book, or put it on hold (if it is currently being read by another student).
- Books remain on the student's device for 2 weeks, but can be returned early.

Accessing Sora from another device

- 1. Download the Sora app. Enter the code mpsnj.
- 2. Select "sign in with Google" and enter your email address & password.
