## $8^{\text {th }}$ Graders

The following criteria must be attained before the end of $8^{\text {th }}$ grade:

- Participate and receive a valid score on:
- PARCC ELA 8
- PARCC Math 8 or PARCC Algebra I
- Maintain Clean Disciplinary Record aligned to Student Code of Conduct
- Adhere to Attendance Policy


## $\mathbf{9}^{\text {th }}$ Graders

The following criteria must be attained before the end of $9^{\text {th }}$ grade:

- Participate and receive a valid score on:
- PARCC ELA 9
- PARCC Algebra I or PARCC Geometry
- Maintain Clean Disciplinary Record aligned to Student Code of Conduct
- Adhere to Attendance Policy


## $10^{\text {th }}$ and $11^{\text {th }}$ Graders

The following criteria must be attained before the end of $10^{\text {th }}$ grade:

- Participate and receive a valid score on:
- PARCC ELA $10^{* *}$
- PARCC Geometry and/or Algebra II**, if applicable
- Maintain G.P.A. of 90+
- Maintain Clean Disciplinary Record aligned to Student Code of Conduct
- Adhere to Attendance Policy
- Reach the age of 16 by September $1^{\text {st }}$ of year enrolled

AND

- SAT Math: 500+
- SAT Evidence-based Reading and Writing: 450+

OR

- Accuplacer Arithmetic: 77
- Accuplacer Elementary Algebra: 76
- Accuplacer Reading Comprehension + Sentence Skills + Writeplacer (15x): 250+

It is recommended that students take the Accuplacer before sitting for the SAT. Students will only have two opportunities to take the Accuplacer to meet the criteria above.
