Greetings and Salutations:

From March 13th to November 30th, are two hundred and sixty days we have missed you! COVID-19 is scary, but our resiliency to overcome is incredible. Our kids continued to learn, grow, and develop during this time through the use of Spring Learning Packets, Summer Adventure, and Fall Online Instruction. The staff and I look forward to continuing this learning journey through our new Hybrid Approach until we can safely return to full-time attendance.

Starting November 30th, our students will have two options for continued learning at White Pass Jr. Sr. High School. First, families will be given the choice of leaving their students on Online Instruction. “**T-Wolf on Demand**” will allow students to attend all classes virtually. Students would be expected to log in, participate, and complete assigned work. Students who choose to remain online will need to stay online until the start of the second semester. Secondly, families will be given another option for on-site instruction using a hybrid approach. “**T-Wolf Live**” will be a blending of online and on-site learning. Students will attend two consecutive days of on-site instruction and finish with three days of online education. All on-site instruction will follow Lewis County Health Department Guidelines. Students will wear safety masks and practice social distancing. Students participating in hybrid learning would be assigned to an “A” Group or “B” Group. Each group would attend separate school days to decrease the exposure risk to COVID-19. All classroom learning environments would be modified to prevent/minimize COVID-19 exposure. Both learning options will provide students the opportunity for continued learning engagement through virtual participation and Google Classroom utilization.

Below is the **T-Wolf Live Hybrid** Schedule.

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Student Group A would attend school on-site Monday and Tuesday and be online Wednesday through Friday. Student Group B would attend school online Monday through Wednesday and attend school on-site Thursday and Friday. Teachers would hold a standard on-site class daily, and students will either follow the class in-person or virtually depending on their assigned day or learning option status. All students will have a rigorous, predictable, and continuous learning schedule. In the event of a school closure, we automatically revert to online learning without any interruptions to instruction.

Further, regardless of the learning option chosen, each student can qualify for food services. As part of a USDA Grant, White Pass SD can offer each student free lunches and breakfast regardless of income level. Also, students who are online for the school day can receive bundled lunches in the district. With both learning options, students will continue to use their Chromebooks in the classroom and at home. All student work will be electronic. Teachers will continue to use Google Classroom to facilitate their classroom instruction, and web cameras and OWLS will be utilized to promote virtual participation and attendance. Likewise, bus transportation will be offered for hybrid learning. Both buildings have worked to keep family and living groups together when creating the student learning groups for hybrid learning.
