Fayetteville High School Full Remote Learning Plan

In the event that the High School is forced to transition to a full remote learning setting the following procedures will be put into place. At this time, there is no intent to do so, however circumstances can change instantly and we want to be prepared. The goal of the Fayetteville High School Full Remote Learning Plan is to maintain the high level of instruction that our teachers provide to students every day in the traditional classroom setting.

Weekly Outlook

Every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday daily assignments will be posted on Google Classroom by 9:30 am. Students will be expected to work at their own pace to complete the required assignments for that day, for each class. On these days teachers will be online from 9:30 am to 2:30 pm to answer questions, work with individual students and to provide feedback.

Students daily attendance will be determined based on their completion of the daily assignments. Students will have four assignments per class per week. If a student completes all assignments they will be marked present, if not, attendance will be adjusted according to the number of assignments completed. Attendance will be updated on Monday mornings.

Students who are in the Rocket Remote Program (PEAK) will remain on that program at least until the end of the semester.

Every Wednesday students are expected to log into Google Meet at the start of each class according to their regular daily school schedule. Teachers will provide a Google Meet platform on each Google Classroom page. Students should follow the link to attend the weekly meeting. During this virtual meeting teachers will review the material that will be covered during that week. Students that do not log in during their class time will be counted as absent. Attendance will be taken at the start of each period.

For students that have no internet, or it is unreliable, the Middle School Gymnasium will be open daily from 7:45 am until 3:00 pm. Students will be able to access the school's internet and do their work in the gym. They must have their own transportation and, of course, wear a mask and be socially distant.
