

Unofficial Minutes (subject to Board approval)
SPECIAL BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING – November 23, 2020

Board President, Jim Rudeen, called the special meeting of the Board of Education of Mission Valley USD #330 to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Elementary Cafeteria at Mission Valley Schools. The meeting was also available via Zoom. Board members present were Jon Deters, Tuff Stephenson, Clinton Lambotte, Clipper Goodrich, Jacob Durkes and Mistina Kraus. The superintendent and board clerk also attended.

Tuff Stephenson moved, seconded by Clinton Lambotte, to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion passed 7 to 0.

Patrons Mary Deters, John Halupa and Chris Tomlinson voiced their opinions about allowing students back for in person learning and returning to sport activities.

Jacob Durkes moved, seconded by Jon Deters, to return to in person learning, practices and activities beginning on November 30, 2020. Motion passed 7 to 0.

Clipper Goodrich moved, seconded by Tuff Stephenson, to allow two spectators per participant for sporting events if it is allowed by Wabaunsee County. Motion passed 7 to 0.

Outside groups will not be allowed to use Mission Valley facilities until further notice.

Fundraising will not be allowed during sporting events.

Visitors will be limited to school business only.

Winter concerts and drama productions scheduled for December will be postponed at this time.

Student birthday parties and holiday parties will consist of no outside visitors and pre-packaged treats only may be sent to school with the children to share with their class.

Tuff Stephenson moved to not allow any sports or extracurricular activities for JH/HS if the 7-12 grade would return to distance learning. Motion died for lack of a second.

Jim Rudeen moved, seconded by Jon Deters, to allow sports and extracurricular activities for JH/HS if the 7-12 grade would return to distance learning. Motion failed 3 to 4, with Clinton Lambotte, Tuff Stephenson, Clipper Goodrich and Jacob Durkes voting no.

Clinton Lambotte moved, seconded by Tuff Stephenson, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 7 to 0. Meeting adjourned at 8:42 p.m.
