**Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**



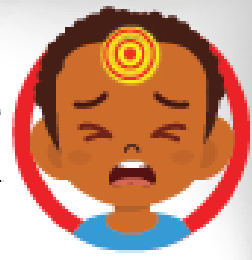
**Fatigue**

**Sore throat**



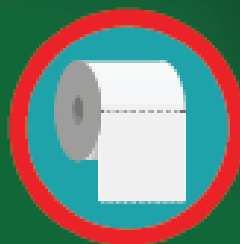
**Congestion or runny nose**
