TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE FUND

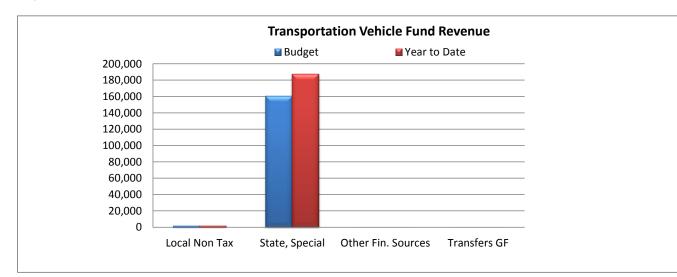

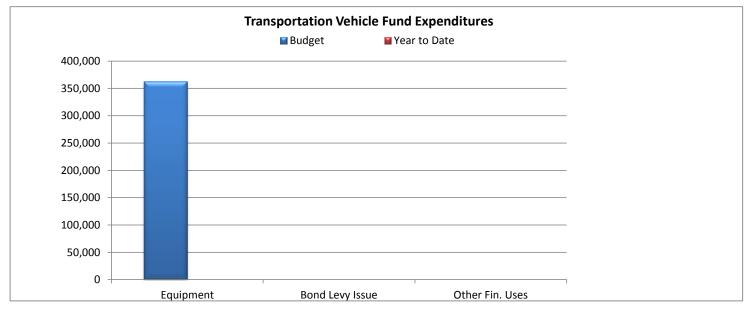

Minimum Fund Balance

The district recognizes the importance of maintaining a prudent fund balance in the general fund to ensure operational cash flow needs are met, to set aside resources for known obligations and to help protect against unforeseen circumstances. Accordingly, the district adopts this policy in regards to those portions of fund balance that are in spendable form but are not legally restricted as to their use from outside sources. Annually, the superintendent or designee will present a general fund budget that includes a commitment of at least 3-5 percent of the current year's expenditures towards a minimum fund balance.

CERTIFICATION OF 2020 EXCESS PROPERTY TAXES

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of North Franklin School District No. J51-162, Franklin and Adams Counties, Washington, certifying to the Superintendent of Educational Service District No. 123 and the Boards of County Commissioners of Franklin and Adams Counties, Washington, the amount of excess property taxes to be levied in year 2020 and collected in year 2021 for the District's General Fund and Debt Service Fund, and providing for related matters.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF NORTH FRANKLIN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. J51-162, FRANKLIN AND ADAMS COUNTIES, WASHINGTON, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Findings and Determinations</u>. The Board of Directors (the "Board") of North Franklin School District No. J51-161, Franklin and Adams Counties, Washington (the "District") takes note of the following facts and makes the following findings and determinations:

(a) By Resolution No. 506, the Board adopted a budget for Fiscal Year 2020-21, (the "2020-21 Budget") that included certified General Fund educational programs and operation excess property taxes in the amount of \$1,950,000 to be levied in 2020 and collected in 2021.

(b) The 2020-21 Budget included certified Debt Service Fund excess property taxes to pay debt service on all of the District's outstanding unlimited tax general obligation bonds in the amount of \$1,310,900 to be levied in 2020 and collected in 2021.

Section 2. Certification of General Fund Excess Property Tax Levy; Assessor Authorization. Pursuant to RCW 84.52.020, the Board certifies to the Superintendent of Educational Service District no. 123 and the Boards of County Commissioners of Franklin and Adams Counties, Washington, an excess property tax levy in the amount of \$1,950,000 to be levied in calendar year 2020 and collected in calendar year 2021 for the District's General Fund. The Assessors of Franklin and Adams Counties, Washington, are authorized and directed, without further Board action, to reduce 2021 GF Levy Amount to be extended upon the tax rolls and collected in calendar year 2021 to the amount that is produced by \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Certification of Debt Service Fund Excess Property Tax Levy</u>. Pursuant to RCW 84.52.020, the Board certifies to the Superintendent of Educational Service District no. 123 and the Boards of County Commissioners of Franklin and Adams Counties, Washington, an excess property tax levy in the amount of \$1,310,900 to be levied in calendar year 2020 and collected in calendar year 2021 for the District's Debt Service Fund.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>General Authorization and Ratification</u>. The Secretary to the Board, the Chair of the Board, the District's Business Manager and other appropriate officers of the District

are severally authorized to take all other actions and execute all other documents necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution, and all prior actions taken in furtherance of and not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution are ratified and confirmed in all respects.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution takes effect from and after its adoption.

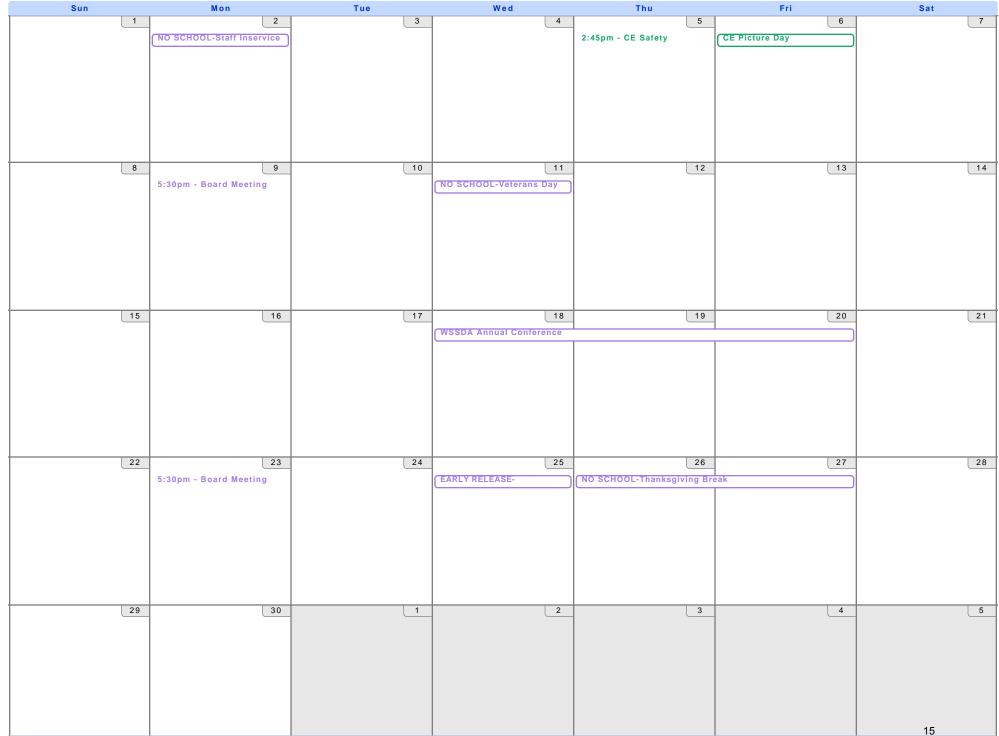

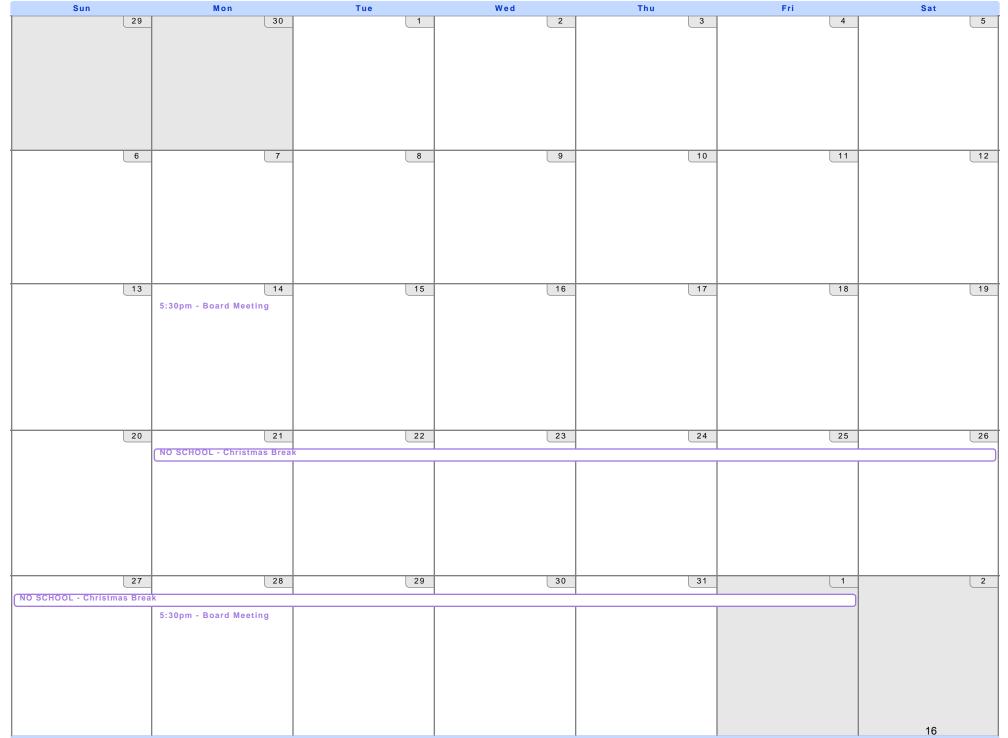

MINUTES NORTH FRANKLIN SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

October 26, 2020 5:30 pm District Office Boardroom

1. CALL TO ORDER/FLAG SALUTE

The meeting was called to order by Chair Utecht at 5:30 pm with Mrs. Hailey, Ms. Chamberlain, Ms. Mendoza and Mr. Jacobs present. Mrs. Walker, Mrs. Booker and Mrs. Sital joined the meeting via Zoom. Mr. Fox joined the meeting after it was called to order.

2. SET AGENDA – ACTION

Mrs. Hailey moved, Mrs. Walker seconded, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed.

3. RECOGNITION OF VISITORS

Chair Utecht welcomed those in attendance.

4. WELCOME LALY MENDOZA – NEW STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE Chair Utecht welcomed Laly Mendoza as new Student Representative.

5. REPORTS

A. Senior LEAP Presentation

Jaxsen Tuttle presented his Senior LEAP presentation about restoring an old truck including repairing fire damage, building a new interior and stripping and repainting the entire truck. Jaxsen brought the restored truck to the board meeting for members to see in person. Board members commended Jaxsen for a job well done.

B. Technology Report

Mr. Mike Borgens provided a report on technology including the new wireless system that was purchased through e-rate funds, updating the district computer network, upgrading computer labs to Windows 10, installing new USB document cameras and recycling over 1000 used computers. He also reported that the district has over 1500 student and staff chrome books to monitor and maintain. Discussion ensued.

- C. Business Manager Reports There were no business manager reports.
- D. Board of Director Reports

Ms. Chamberlain and Ms. Mendoza shared results of a student survey they put out on the CHS Instagram page regarding entry screening, face masks, hygiene/handwashing and sanitation. Discussion ensued.

E. Superintendent Report

Mr. Jacobs reported that the district has been in the hybrid in-person instruction model for a month and it has gone very well. He stated that he and administrators continue to make adjustments as needed for improvement. He also stated that the next big hurdle is to get all students back in school every day, when allowed.

Mr. Jacobs reported that the ending fund balance is higher due to less spending in the spring during the school closure, no activities, transportation, less food service, etc. He

also reported that he expects funding will be impacted later this year with ridership being down and possible state funding reductions, and it is important for the district to prepare for this. Mr. Jacobs reported that some schools around the region are using snow days as virtual school days in lieu of non-school snow days so that the days don't have to be made up. Mr. Jacobs shared that this impacts classified staff not working on those days as well. Discussion ensued and it was decided that if it's a random snow day it won't be a virtual school day, but in the event we can determine that there will be multiple days, the district could possibly provide virtual school days in lieu of non-school snow days.

Mr. Jacobs had no additional items to discuss regarding the 2020-21 School Year Reopening Update.

B. CHS Costa Rica Trip

Mr. Jacobs informed board members that the advisors coordinating the CHS Costa Rica trip talked with parents and reached a majority consensus to cancel the trip. It has been communicated that the board would concur with the decision to cancel the trip. Discussion ensued and board members agreed with the decision to cancel the trip.
