SUMMER LIBRARY

From the School Nurse:

As summer is approaching I think the last thing on everyone's mind is the upcoming school year. I just want to remind everyone of the grade level requirements for all returning and new students to our district. Please do your best to get these to either Tonya Doyle or Rachel Heck before the beginning of the school year. Any student new to the district must have a physical, dental exam, eye exam and all vaccines appropriate for their grade level unless an exemption is signed and reviewed. The requirements are as follows: Any student coming in Pre-K is to have a physical exam and a copy of all required immunizations. Kindergarten is to have a physical exam, a dental exam, a vision exam, and all required vaccines. Second grade must have a dental and vision exam completed. Sixth grade dental exam, physical, 1Tdap, 1Meningitis, and all other required vaccines. Ninth grade physical, record of immunizations and a dental exam. Seniors need proof of both Meningitis vaccines. Sports physicals do not count for the state



required physicals but you may use the one from your doctor instead of getting a sports physical. The HPV vaccine series is not required but highly recommend for all students entering sixth grade. All medical or religious exemptions need to be signed by a doctor and submitted by August 4th 2023 for review. The only exemptions that the state of Illinois recognizes are those of a religious objection or medical, these students are required to have a medical exam every year they attend school.
