How to get into Seesaw

Step 1

- *Go to app.seesaw.me (for laptops or computers) or Download the **Seesaw Class App** (tablets or mobile devices, be sure to update) for Your Child*

*Your child will use the **Seesaw Class app** for home learning. (This is different than the Seesaw Family app.)*

- *Can students access activities in the Family app?*

No. Students can access activities in the Class app by signing in with their @wtnstudents.org email.

How to get into Seesaw:

Step 2:

Help Your Child Log In to Seesaw

- *Click 'I'm a Student'*
 - *Log in as directed by your student's teacher or school:*
- ✓ *Your child will log in with his/her Watertown email address:*

student'sname@wtstudents.org

Password: "my child's first name" + student ID

Example: maryo10011

How to get into Seesaw

TROUBLE LOGGING IN?

- ✓ *Make sure your child is signing in to the CLASS app (Students cannot complete remote learning activities on the Family app)*
- ✓ *Make sure your child clicks 'I'm a Student'*
- ✓ *Make sure your child enters login credentials as shown with no typos; if scanning a code, make sure to stand far enough away for the entire code to be scanned*

Seesaw FAQs

I'm a family member. Can my child and I use the same email address to log into the Class app and Family app?

- *No. You and your child need unique email addresses. If you try to use the same email address for a student account and a family account, you will receive an error message*
