How to get into Seesaw

Step 1

 Go to app.seesaw.me (for laptops or computers) or Download the Seesaw Class App (tablets or mobile devices, be sure to update) for Your Child

Your child will use the **Seesaw Class app** for home learning. (This is different than the Seesaw Family app.)

Can students access activities in the Family app?

No. Students can access activities in the Class app by signing in with their **@wtnstudents.org email**.

Help Your Child Log In to Seesaw

- Click 'I'm a Student'
- Log in as directed by your student's teacher or school:
 - ✓ Your child will log in with his/her Watertown email address:

student'sname@wtnstudents.org

Password: "my child's first name" + student ID

Example: maryo10011

How to get into Seesaw

TROUBLE LOGGING IN?

- ✓ Make sure your child is signing in to the CLASS app (Students cannot complete remote learning activities on the Family app)
- ✓ Make sure your child clicks 'I'm a Student'
- ✓ Make sure your child enters login credentials as shown with no typos; if scanning a code, make sure to stand far enough away for the entire code to be scanned

Seesaw FAQs

I'm a family member. Can my child and I use the same email address to log into the Class app and Family app?

• No. You and your child need unique email addresses. If you try to use the same email address for a student account and a family account, you will receive an error message
