COVID-19 Gymnasium Protocols for Basketball

(updated 2-12-21)

The following protocols have been developed based on the most recent information from the NSAA, local DHM's and the CDC. All guidelines are subject to change without notice.

Capacity

- Based on the current DHM's, and in accordance with the NSAA requirements, we will be able to use up to 75% of our gym capacity. Taking into consideration where each school will sit, we are going to allow 325 guests for Fillmore Central.
- We will be allowing 225 guests for the visiting school.

Striv

• We are going to Striv all games.

PPE

- As per NSAA guidelines, the following items will be in place:
 - Active participants are permitted, but not required, to wear face coverings during competition.
 - Coaches and non-active participants (those not currently on the court, mat or stage) are required to wear face coverings at all times. Cheer and dance are considered not-active participants.
 - Spectators are required to wear face coverings at all times while attending indoor events.
 - Face coverings must cover the nose and mouth.

Entrance and Exit Strategies & Occupancy

• All fans will enter at the main entrance (H-1). Fillmore Central fans will occupy the west bleachers and visiting fans will occupy the east bleachers.

Restrooms & Concessions

- There is only one set of restrooms at the high school, so everyone will have the same access
- We only have one concession stand. We ask that everyone do their best to social distance while in line, and as per NSAA guidelines, the use of facial coverings are required.
- All water fountains will be locked, however, bottle filling stations will be accessible.

Postgame

- Spectators will not be allowed on the gym floor after the game.
- Spectators are asked to leave promptly after the conclusion of the game, and are politely asked to not congregate indoors.
- Athletes will not be allowed to come and visit with family after the game.
