Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative Scholarships (APRIL 30 each year)

Added- August 2020

Applicant must be either a Coles- Moultrie Electric Cooperative (CMEC) member or under 21 years of age and a legal dependent of a Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative member. Applicant must be enrolled in 2 or 4 year degree program at an accredited institution including vocational/technical schools and will be judged based on academics, volunteer/community involvement, written essay and neatness of application.

Farm Credit Illinois (March 12, 2021)

Added- November 2020

Thirty \$2,000 Agriculture Scholarships are available to high school seniors planning to enroll in an agriculture-based college curriculum next fall. Two applicants will be designated "Diversity in Agriculture Scholars."

IEA-NEA Michael Hindman Teacher Education Scholarship (MARCH 1, 2021)

Added- November 2020

This scholarship fund was established in honor of Mr. Hindman, who dedicated his life to the betterment of education and teachers in our area. A yearly scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans to pursue a career in education. This year one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded in the spring and paid when the student begins his/her student teaching assignment (within 3 to 6 years).

IEC Memorial Scholarship Fund (DECEMBER 31, 2020)

Added- August 2020

Six scholarships will be awarded to students who are the sons or daughters of an electric cooperative member who resides in Illinois and is receiving service from the cooperative at the time the scholarship application is submitted.

A seventh scholarship- the Earl W. Struck Memorial Scholarship- will be awarded to a student who is the son or daughter of an electric cooperative employee or director who resides in Illinois.

LaVern and Nola McEntire Lineworker's Scholarship (APRIL 30, 2021)

Added- August 2020

This \$2,000 scholarship will help pay for costs to attend the lineworker's school conducted by the Association of Illinois Electric Cooperatives (AIEC) in conjunction with Lincoln Land Community College, Springfield, IL.
