Millington Community Schools Update on COVID Exposure and Closure

November 10, 2020

Dear Parents and Community Members:

At this time, Millington Community Schools, has a staff member who has tested positive for COVID-19. All individuals, staff and students, who may have had close contact with the employee have been notified and asked to begin the quarantine period.

Our staff members have diligently reported health concerns, staying home when feeling ill or when learning of potential contact/exposure to best ensure our student's and staff's health and safety.

We have begun performing contact tracing with the assistance of the Tuscola County Health Department and have identified all close contacts with the staff member. We have contacted those students and families and have asked to begin the quarantine period. The Tuscola County Health Department will follow up with further contacts, information and instructions. Please be patient with this process as this is where none of us want to be.

I will follow up with further details as they become available both through Millington Community Schools and the Tuscola County Health Department. Therefore, Millington Community Schools has made the decision, as a precautionary measure, to go to distance/virtual learning for all K-12 students for the rest of the week with further re-evaluation and decisions being made by the end of the day on Friday, November 13, 2020. This is exactly what other schools have done in order to prevent larger groups from gathering within their buildings.

Please stay tuned for further updates.

There will be no Tech Center, but Early Childhood Special Education, Food Service and other activities will continue as scheduled unless otherwise notified.

I know that this is difficult for us all at this time. We have truly been taking all of this one day at a time, trying to prepare for the worst and always hoping for the best.
