## School Schedule

- School Hours: 8 a.m. - 3 p.m.** Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday
- and 8 a.m. - 1 p.m.** Wednesday
- Teachers are available during regular school hours. Teachers will send meeting details to families and/or students as applicable.
- School offices are limiting visitors; call ahead if you need in-person assistance from school personnel.
- Students may be allowed to come into the school building for interventions or other additional supports during distance learning.

## Technology

Kindergarten - Grade 12 students will be sent home with their individually checked out school Chromebook and charger. Devices should be kept with chargers. A limited number of wifi hotspots are available; contact the school office to learn more. The high school parking lot is equipped with wifi and may be accessed by students or family from their vehicles with student devices.



## Health

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## Learning Expectations:

Students should use the transition dates 11/10-11/13 to complete and submit late or incomplete work to their teachers for full or partial credit (as determined by individual teachers) if submitted over the transition period. No new content will be assigned to students during these dates.

Starting Nov 16th, students should be accessing Schoology to find their course content every learning day. Content will be organized in week/folder format for easy access and promoting student independence. Students are expected to participate in teacher scheduled meetings as organized by their teachers.

Students or parents must log-in to Infinite Campus Student or Parent Portal to Check-in each learning day starting Monday 11/16. Please use the included guide for additional instructions. Contact the school office if you need help with user account information or to report an excused absence.

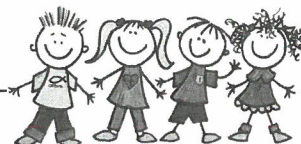


## Athletics/Activities/Community Education

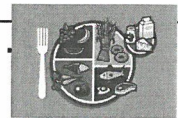
Athletics and Activities will be cancelled for the week of November 9th. Plans to return to activities will be communicated from the Activities Office as more information becomes available.
