DRIVER RESPONSIBILITIES:

SAFETY IS A TOP PRIORITY

- Remember to follow good driving procedures at all time.
 - Failure to do so may result in loss of parking privileges for up to the remainder of the school year and other appropriate disciplinary action.
- Allow yourself enough time to park in your assigned parking place.
 - Haste causes accidents.
 - Punctuality is required to keep both your parking place and your Gold/Silver Card.
 - Display your parking permit **PROMINENTLY**. (It must be **visible** in the registered vehicle)
 - A vehicle without a parking permit may be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense.
- Keep your parked vehicle locked. Students may not return to their cars during the regular school day. Only seniors with their Gold Cards displayed may get into their cars at lunch.
 - No passengers are permitted. Having passengers may result in revocation of parking place, Gold Card, and other possible disciplinary action.
- Be respectful of pedestrians, cars, and buses.
 - Drive responsibly, be alert and safe.
 - Keep your speed under 10 mph on school grounds.
- Wear your seatbelt and drive safely.
- If someone parks illegally in your space:
 - Park in the visitor space in front of school.
 - Report the make, model & plate number with your parking space number to the Dean of Students or the main office.
- Stay current with the parking expectations by referring to your handbook.
- Remember: Driving is a Privilege; Not a Right.
