The speaker will email comments, prior to the beginning of the meeting. Individual speakers will be allowed three minutes to address the Board on each agenda or non-agenda item.

In order to ensure that non-English speakers receive the same opportunity to directly address the Board, Google Translate will be used to translate any emails to the Superintendent who will receive and present

the public comments in open session.

Comments are greatly appreciated, however please note that the Board cannot enter into a formal discussion, nor can a decision be made on any item that is not already on the agenda. Items the Board wishes to consider for future discussion can be placed on an upcoming agenda.

Routine items are placed under the Consent Calendar and are approved by a single vote of the Board. When the agenda is adopted, a member of the Board can pull an item from the Consent Calendar and move the item to the agenda for discussion.

Individuals who require special accommodation to participate in a board meeting, including but not limited to an American Sign Language interpreter or documentation in accessible formats, should contact the Superintendent's office 48 hours prior to the meeting to

enable the district to make reasonable arrangements to ensure accommodation and accessibility to this meeting.
