El Fidelity Data

- We will begin gathering Fidelity Data starting this fall, with the implementation of PBIS.
 - Behavior referrals will be reported through the SWIS ???
 - Continue gathering academic data through NWEA assessments, classroom grades and progress and report cards
 - Steve Walters will serve as point person to gather this Fidelity Data

- Climate Surveys being sent to Students, Staff and Parents this month
 - This will create baseline data for comparison purposes as we begin implementation of the EI
- We will be able to start sharing this Fidelity Data next year.

Impact on Students

- We will begin gathering data on this next year, with the implementation of PBIS (EI).
- Once we start gathering data and have comparison data to evaluate, we will have valuable data to determine impact on students.
- Data used to determine impact will include:
 - Climate Surveys
 - NWEA Assessments
 - Behavioral/discipline referrals

- We will add questions to this annual survey about implementation supports in April 2024

Upcoming Work to Scale up the El

As we begin implementation, we are making efforts to train and inform ALL staff. This EI (Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports) is really an all-district effort and will take all staff – not just classroom.

May 18th 2-hour delay – Support Staff PBIS in-service May 26th All Day In-Service - PBIS Classroom Teacher Training
