Hello Greenwood Families!

We hope this letter finds you safe, healthy, and well. We also hope you were able to enjoy the Thanksgiving break. On Monday, December 7, students will return to in-person learning as scheduled. Buses will return to their normal routes as were done prior to the virtual learning closure. Saying that, here are some reminders about our current health situation.

Each morning, please continue to assess the health of your child. **If your child presents any symptoms of Covid-19, please do NOT send them to school.** These symptoms include cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell, fever, chills, muscle aches, headache, sore throat, fatigue, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea. Contact the office immediately if you need to keep your child home or if you need assistance in making that decision.

Masks are still required at school at all times indoors. **These masks must cover the nose and mouth and should be worn appropriately throughout the day.** If a student does not have a mask, there are boxes of masks at each entrance to our schools. Students will also be asked to wash and/or sanitize their hands upon entering our buildings and throughout the day.

Recently, you may have heard about the modifications the CDC has made to their recommendations for quarantining. This includes quarantines for positive cases and close contacts. These recommendations are currently being reviewed by the State Health Department. Their recommendation will be given to our County Health Department and they will inform us of any changes being made to quarantining in Clark County. If or when that happens, the School District of Greenwood will communicate these changes. As of now, quarantine rules remain the same as they have been over the past several months.

Lastly, we want to thank you all for your dedication and work with our kids over the past couple of weeks. We know that virtual learning is not easy. Oftentimes, it is much more difficult than in-person learning. Overall, we had great participation which will allow us to continue our learning moving forward! If you have any feedback or questions, it is welcomed and will help us continue our improvement should we need to close for virtual learning again. Together, we will continue to keep Greenwood strong and a great place for our kids!
