Harvard District 50 Hosts Kindergarten Registration January 23 & 28

HARVARD, Ill. — Harvard District 50 hosts kindergarten registration on Thursday, January 23 from 4 to 8 p.m. and Tuesday, January 28, from 4 to 8 p.m. at Crosby Elementary School for families of children entering kindergarten in the fall of 2020.

During the event, parents will receive information about physicals, immunizations, transportation, the district's dual language program.

To be eligible to attend kindergarten during the 2020-21 school year:

- Children must be five years old on or before September 1, 2020
- State law requires an original or certified copy of a child's birth certificate at the time of registration.
- Families must provide three proofs of residency (such as a tax bill, utility bill, lease agreement, or a voter's registration card).

A registration fee of \$115 will be collected. If a family is unable to pay the full fee at registration, a payment plan can be set up with an initial down payment required at registration.

An additional screening will be held, for students not enrolled in the Washington Preschool Program. Qualified families will be asked to sign up for a screening time during registration. The screenings last 20 minutes and are a way to gauge each child's current level of development. Information obtained from screenings is used as a guide to best plan for individual students as they enter Crosby.

All registrations and screenings will take place at Crosby Elementary School located at 401 Hereley Drive in Harvard.
