# Warren New Tech High School

Updated July 25, 2023



# Background

Warren New Tech High School (WNTHS), located at 219 Highway 158 Bypass, Warrenton, NC 27589, serves students in grades 9-12. All rising 9th graders may apply to attend WNTHS. No students are automatically assigned to attend the school and there is no base attendance area for student assignment.

WNTHS was designed around a project based learning model, where students do collaborative projects with classmates to learn academic content, including core standards of study. Under the model, classes were to be student-directed with teachers as facilitators, not lecturers. Through the pandemic and staff turnover, current staff have not been properly trained to provide instruction using the project based learning model, resulting in more traditional teaching and learning methods similar to Warren County High School (WCHS).

WNTHS was tentatively scheduled to be closed at the end of the 2023-24 school year as part of the Board of Education's long-range plans to consolidate schools into one elementary school, one middle school, and one high school in a centralized location in the county. Warren County Schools has secured a \$30 million grant to use the WNTHS campus for the new, consolidated elementary school, with renovations and construction tentatively scheduled to begin in fall 2024.

The WNTHS facility has the capacity to serve approximately 140 students, based on the 21,000 square foot size of the facility and the recommendation of 150 square feet per high school student. In the 2022-23 school year, there were only 75 students enrolled at WNTHS.

This study is exploring the option of closing WNTHS and moving the students and staff to an innovative learning environment at a new and improved WCHS.

# **GEOGRAPHIC CONDITIONS**

WNTHS is centrally located in the county, next to the WCHS and Warren County Middle School (WCMS) campuses. This makes it an ideal location for a centralized and consolidated elementary school, as included in our long-range capital improvement plan. Warren County Schools received a \$30 million grant to transform the WNTHS campus into a new Warren County Elementary School, with construction tentatively scheduled to begin in fall 2024.

### ANTICIPATED INCREASE OR DECREASE IN SCHOOL ENROLLMENT

Only 11 rising 9th grade students applied to attend WNTHS for the 2023-24 school year, bringing the school's total enrollment to just 64 students. This is consistent with a trend over the past five years of steadily decreasing enrollment at WNTHS, as shown on the chart below. The low enrollment creates economic hardships of scale which are difficult to sustain, with current

WNTHS class sizes of 8-10 students, significantly below the state average and allotted funding levels.

# INCONVENIENCE OR HARDSHIP THAT MIGHT RESULT TO THE PUPILS TO BE AFFECTED BY SUCH CLOSING AND CONSOLIDATION

The location change from WNTHS to WCHS poses minimal inconvenience as the two campuses are nearly adjacent to each other separated by a tree line. The main driveways to both schools are off the same road and within less than a mile of each other. Students will still ride the same bus to WCHS.

WCHS operates on a slightly different calendar than WNTHS. On the traditional calendar used by WNTHS, school would start on August 28, 2023 and end on June 7, 2024. At WCHS, school starts on August 8, 2023 and ends on May 22, 2024, allowing students to finish the second semester and take exams before winter break.

# COST OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL SCHOOL FACILITIES IN THE EVENT OF SUCH CLOSING AND CONSOLIDATION

WCHS has additional capacity available, so it's able to absorb the WNTHS students and staff with little to no additional cost. The consolidation aligns with the school district's ongoing capital improvement plan to modernize and update our schools, including WCHS. Warren County Schools is making significant investments to replace outdated furniture at WCHS with modern, flexible furniture designed to promote collaboration and creativity in a 21st century learning environment.

# Other important factors

# POSSIBLE ALTERNATIVE USES OF THE SCHOOL FACILITY BY THE DISTRICT

This proposed closing is part of the Board of Education's long-range plans to consolidate schools into one elementary school, one middle school, and one high school in a centralized location in the county.

Warren New Tech High School was tentatively scheduled to close at the end of the 2023-24 school year so construction and renovations could begin on the facility for the new, consolidated elementary school.

The recommendation to close WNTHS before the 2023-24 school year just moves that plan ahead by one year.

# THE POTENTIAL EFFECT ON SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Under our current district and school structure, not all high school students have access to the same high-level academic courses, career and technical education electives, and other resources. Combining the schools will allow WCHS to offer advanced placement courses that weren't previously available for students. The combined school will also allow WNTHS students access to electives and extracurricular activities like our Space Force program, SparkNC High-Tech Learning Lab, flight simulators, robotics club, masonry, etc. Warren County Schools is working to transform our system of teaching and learning to focus on improving academic outcomes and providing high-quality instruction and support so ALL students can thrive and realize their full potential.

Additionally, moving students out of WNTHS allows us to use the facility to operate an Alternative Learning Program for students with challenges and needs that can best be served outside of the traditional classroom and school setting. This is not a separate school, so it will not need its own administrator. The school district expects this will significantly reduce disciplinary issues and disruptions at WCHS and WCMS.

# FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The WNTHS closure would result in significant savings in personnel costs for the district. The current student enrollment of only 64 students falls short of the required 100-student threshold to receive state funding for a principal. Consequently, the district has been forced to use local funding to cover this expense.

The state only provides one instructional support position per 222.36 students. Low enrollment at WNTHS only yields one-third of a state funded instructional support position. The district must use local funding to cover the remaining two-thirds of the cost to employ a full-time school counselor for WNTHS.

Regardless of the size of a high school, public school units must provide the same core classes required for earning a diploma in North Carolina. The abnormally low enrollment at WNTHS led to class sizes nearly one-third of the typical class size for traditional high schools. This forced the district to find funding to hire four more teachers than the state would pay for.

WNTHS also requires clerical support to handle day to day functions of the school such as bookkeeping, data management, and receptionist responsibilities. This level of administrative overhead would no longer be necessary by merging the two high school campuses.

The savings to the district as a result of administration's proposal to merge the two campuses are as follows:

Important Note: The district does not intend to lay off any employees as a result of this merger. Employees who want to remain with the district will be reassigned to other locations, mostly at WCHS to fill vacant positions.

# Conclusion

The proposed merger of WCHS and WNTHS would strengthen our entire school district in the following ways:

- Increase the number of licensed and highly qualified teachers serving all students at WCHS/WNTHS
- Improve academic performance for all students at WCHS/WNTHS
- Expand the course offerings for all students at WCHS/WNTHS
- Use the \$558,000 cost savings to meet other needs in the district
- Reduce disciplinary issues because of increased staffing levels at WCHS/WNTHS and the creation
  of a daytime alternative learning program for students who would benefit from a different
  learning environment
- Increase access to specialized programs and extracurricular activities
- Unify students, families, and the community behind a new and continuously improving Warren County High School and the Eagles mascot

# **RECOMMENDATION**

Because of these significant benefits for all students in Warren County Schools, staff recommends combining Warren New Tech High School with Warren County High School in the 2023-24 school year.




